- # 3 Duisburg Hbf (Central Railway Station), 12.45 [pm] with direct rail access from Amsterdam

Final destination: Den Haag Central Railway Station, 21.22 [9.22 pm]

Sites / Via:

- Brühl, Stern square, pedestrian priority zone with vehicle traffic (# 1a and # 1b only)
- Hennes, Frankfurter Street, multifunctional central reserve (# 1a, # 1b and # 2 only)
- Duisburg, Opera Square, pedestrian priority zone with large vehicle traffic
- Bohmte, Bremer Street, Shared Space type Naked Street
