Boda boda: context

## Context

boda boda increased in Tanzania by 10 000% (2003–2016)

performs public transport function

over-represented in traffic fatalities

cheap low-quality vehicles

unsafe behaviours

helmet usage (incl. passengers)

unfavourable working conditions

Mr. Minister calls for a meeting...

## Policy Consultation Hearing to find out:

- whether boda boda should still be allowed on roads
- if yes, what aspects should be regulated (technical admission, rider and equipment requirements, ...)
- what facilities should be provided by authorities
- what enforcement is needed and how this may be ensured
